L O R R A I N E

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width across top, approx 82in/208cm.

Length front center back to point, approx 34in/86cm.

MATERIALS

- 5 x 100g cakes of Ella Rae **Marmel Duo** in shade 205 Norwich.
- Crochet hook size US 7/4.5mm or size to obtain gauge.
- Yarn needle.

GAUGE

3.6 sts and 8.75 rows in the c2c blocks pattern = 4in/10cm

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

ABBREVIATIONS

approx approximate(ly); **ch** chain; **dc** double crochet; **sl** slip; **sp** space.

NOTES

1. Shawl is made using corner to corner technique (c2c), increasing 1 c2c at the end of every row.
2. When shawl is complete 3 tassels are made using all remaining yarn, then 1 tassel is attached to each of the 3 corners.
3. The pattern is reversible.



INSTRUCTIONS

BEGIN C2C BLOCKS PATTERN

Row 1 Ch 6, work dc in 4th ch from hook, 1 dc in next 2 ch, turn—1 c2c block made.

Row 2 Ch 6, work dc in 4th ch from hook, 1 dc in next 2 ch, sl st into ch-3 sp on next block, ch 3, 3 dc in same sp, turn—2 c2c blocks.

Row 3 Ch 6, dc in 4th ch from hook, 1 dc in next 2 ch, *sl st into ch-3 sp on next block, ch 3, 3 dc in same sp, repeat from * to end, turn—1 c2c block inc'd.

Rows 4–74 Rep Row 3—74 c2c blocks in last row. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

TASSELS (MAKE 3)

Cut remaining yarn into strands, each approx 10in/25.5cm long. Divide the strands into 3 equal piles, hold aside 12 extra strands. Lay one pile of strands neatly across the midpoint of 2 extra strands, tie these 2 strands around mid-point of pile of strands and pull tight, then make a knot leaving a length for attaching tassel to the shawl. Fold the pile of strands in half, wrap 2 more strands around several times at 1½in/4cm below the fold to form tassel neck. Tie securely then with tapestry needle, thread yarn tails through center of tassel to hide them. Trim tassel ends evenly. Using photo as guide, attach 1 tassel to each of the 3 points. ❖
